In 1924 Rudolf Steiner lectured about the karma of the Anthroposophical Society and he mentioned also upcoming events. USHER pursues the interesting question, whether today, by looking back to the end of the 20th Century, we can identify this culmination. His approach is subtle. And he comes to the tentative conclusion: The culmination succeeded, but we didn't recognize it.

The Section for Mathematics and Astronomy at the Goetheanum organized a big conference from January 2nd to 5th, 2012. Central themes were the 100th anniversary of the Anthroposophical Calendar, the Maya-Calendar and two apocalyptic seals. During this conference the play
